

## Suggestions for Best results using PRO-CONE Squirrel

- Determine squirrel activity by locating entry and exit point(s) on structure.
- Install cone(s) over hole(s). <u>Please note</u> Squirrel cone(s) can be installed at any angle.
- It's imperative to "squirrel proof" all *inactive* areas of structure before installing cone(s) to prevent squirrels from relocating to other areas such as: Attic vents, louvers, corners of dormers and soffit areas etc... We suggest using metal flashing and/or 1/4 inch wire mesh (hardware cloth) to help prevent possible reinfestation.
- We recommend leaving squirrel cone(s) in place for a minimum of three (3) to five (5) days to insure that squirrels are out.
- When you are certain that squirrels are gone, remove squirrel
  cone(s) and seal hole(s) with metal flashing and trim trees
  around structure to help prevent further re-infestation.

## Caution!

<u>DO NOT remove squirrels during their birthing cycles!</u> This will result in offspring becoming trapped inside!!!

Failure to follow these directions, will force female squirrel to chew her way back in to reach her young!!!
